Transcript showing your Senior Year cumulative GPA, ACT or SAT test scores, class rank, and attendance record.

Part II – A typed essay of 500 to 800 words. Complete Essay Questions in the boxes below. Please discuss academic and career goals. Please consider including the following:

- participation in **TRIO** Upward Bound opportunities,
- impact from your participation in TRIO Upward Bound,
- life experiences.

Montana Tech Gold Access Scholarships

Montana Tech Gold Access Scholarship was established to provide high-ability, highly committed students a two semester tuition waiver at **Montana Technological University**. This scholarship is awarded to the top applicant from each **TRIO** program hosted by **Montana Technological University**.

Upward Bound Spirit Award

The Upward Bound Spirit Award was established by the **TRIO** Upward Bound Student Government to reward graduating seniors who actively participate in **TRIO** academies and activities. This scholarship is funded by the local fundraising efforts by **TRIO** scholars.

Dale Theil Memorial Scholarship

The Dale Theil Memorial Scholarship was established to actively encourage **TRIO MTUB** graduating scholars to live balanced lives.
